**WHAT CAMPAIGN?**

Dear Friends,

Some folks have been asking, "When are we going to start the campaign to raise money for the church renovation?" The answer is that we actually have already begun, albeit quietly.

Just as a refresher, you remember that the community made a decision to use the money from the Pierce Fund (restricted to be used for the upkeep/repair of the church only) as "seed" money to get the work started as soon as possible during the winter. That was done and the work has been completed (with the exception of the handicapped door "pads" and possibly some lighting for the ceiling).

We have spent approximately \$350,000 on all of the work which includes the interior renovation, a completely new heating system and some roof repairs. So we are trying to raise as much of that figure as possible to restore the funds that we "borrowed" from ourselves to get the work started.

A few weeks ago we placed slips of paper in the pews that described the various ways that those wishing to contribute could do so. As of today we have about \$33,000 in pledges or almost 10% of our stated goal.

We are trying to make this a low key, no pressure campaign and simply ask people to do whatever they feel comfortable with. We are certainly very grateful to Mrs. Pierce, whose large donation has made so many repairs to the church possible over recent history. We would like to ensure that she is not solely responsible for the beautiful work that was done to restore our church. It belongs to all of us and hopefully we can take responsibility as a community for keeping our church in good repair for the next twenty-five years. As always, thanks for your incredibly generous support of your church!

**The Battle Hymn of the Republic**

Elementary school children often come up with their own words for the tune of the "Battle Hymn of the Republic." If we reach back into our grade school experience we'll remember our own version of the chorus, "Glory, glory, hallelujah!" What many of us don't realize is that when we did that we were doing exactly what Juliet Ward Howe did when she penned the famous lyrics that we sing today. The words of a well-known campfire spiritual, "Canaan's Happy Shore," were adapted by the men of Massachusetts 12th Regiment at the beginning of the Civil War. They were singing "John Brown's body lies a-moldering in the grave," as a rallying song using "Canaan's" tune. In 1861 Howe wrote the words that we know today, and that were popularized when they were published in *The Atlantic Monthly* in 1862.
