Dear Friends,

There is an expression that we use in AA that goes like this: "If you always do what you always did you'll always get what you always got!" It is amusing (sometimes) to watch someone attempt something over and over and continue to get bad results because they keep repeating the same mistake.

Sometimes it takes a lot of courage to change our ways or dare to follow a path away from the crowd. It takes a certain measure of self-confidence or a bit of valor to be oneself when that is not popular. Certainly Pope John XXIII caught the curia by surprise when he stood firm in his decision to call the Second Vatican Council. President Richard Nixon was uniquely "un-Republican" when he set up wage and price controls and when he made an historic presidential visit to communist China. Governor Patterson has riled up a lot of folks by insisting that New York must balance its budget and stop spending the inheritance of its grandchildren.

Some believe that in a civil society we must all learn to get along in spite of our differences of opinion. While that may be true a majority of the time there is still a role for a "loose cannon" every now and then. This is especially true when institutional authority of any ilk insists that loyalty to the group is the highest value. Unless that "group" is the Blessed Trinity, that kind of loyalty would always be misplaced.

Habits and predictability are nice and comfortable – like an oversize sweater but they may not be what is needed to move a group forward. When the times require bold initiatives that deflect us from the beaten path we would do well to enthusiastically welcome and follow those who are willing to blaze an uncommon trail.

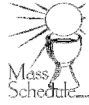
